

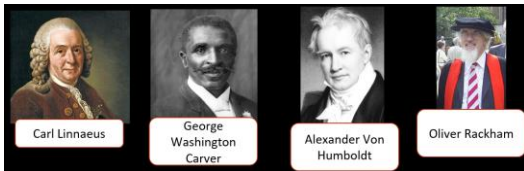


Science

Living things and their habitats:

- observe and describe how seeds and bulbs grow into mature plants
- find out and describe how plants need water, light and a suitable temperature to grow and stay healthy

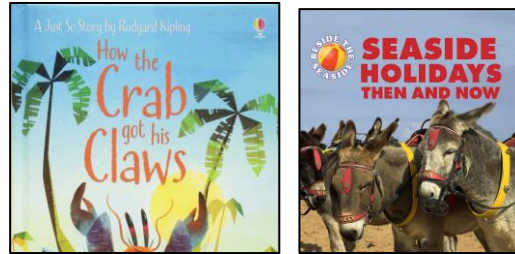
We will be learning about the conditions plants need for optimal growth and using this information to consider whether certain plants would be suitable for our local climate. We will also be learning about the work of a number of influential Botanists.



- What happens if we do not water the plant?
- What happens if the plant did not get any sunlight?
- What happens if the seeds are too hot or too cold?

Beside the Seaside



Outcome: Writing and sharing our own just so stories. Shoe box habitats.

History

History of beach holidays: Know that children's lives today are different to those of children a long time ago. Learn about changes within living memory.

Outcome: Write and film an advert for a beach holiday in the past.
