Work on your spelling bronze, silver and gold. Remember to bring them in to be tested as soon as you're done.



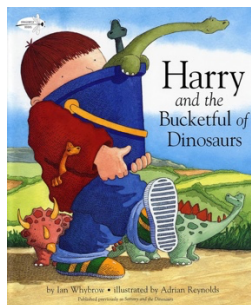
Aim to complete a level over this half term.
