Listen to an adult read the words aloud and see if you can remember how to write them without copying.



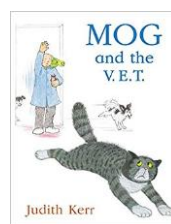
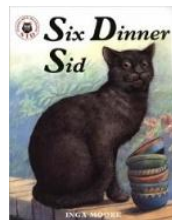
Literacy
