### Geography

#### Time zones

Know about time zones and work out differences countries. Know where the Meridians are on a world map. **The children will use maps to identify countries with different time zone, to identify the Meridians and help them explain what time zones are.**

### English

**Persuasion** – Construct an argument to persuade others of a point of view and present the case to the class or group; use standard English appropriately; evaluate its effectiveness.

**Children will be writing a letter, in which they will need to use arguments for and against to persuade Dr Bryce to either choose Cameron as his candidate or not.**

**Balanced argument**- Provides different points of view on an issue, paying attention to the arguments for and against the issue being discussed. **Inspired by a topic of children’s own interest, the children will write a balanced argument.**

**Children will write an persuasive letter as one of the characters in the book.**

**Wow moment:** Children will act out the journey of the red blood cell.

### Science

Identify and name the main parts of the human circulatory system.

Know the function of the heart, blood vessels and blood. Know the impact of diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle on health.

Know the ways in which nutrients and water are transported in animals, including humans.

**Children will learn about how the heart works and its structure. They will participate in drama to show their understanding.**

### DT

Know which tool to use for a specific practical task. Know how to use any tool correctly and safely.

Know how to test and evaluate designed products.

Evaluate product against clear criteria.

**Children will be using their knowledge of electricity they learnt in year 4 and last half term to make a steady hand game.**
