Textiles – waistcoats

Using a combination of textiles skills such as attaching fastenings, appliqué and decorative stitches, children design, assemble and decorate a waistcoat for a chosen purpose.

The children will complete a series of lessons where they will learn basic stitching skills and steps into making a garment. The children will create their own waistcoats following as a memoir of their time at primary school.
